The bill requires school districts to adopt Integrated Pest Management plans, create a list of acceptable low-impact pesticides, and designate an IMP coordinators. Section 11 of SB 637 states plans shall be implemented on or before July 1, 2012.

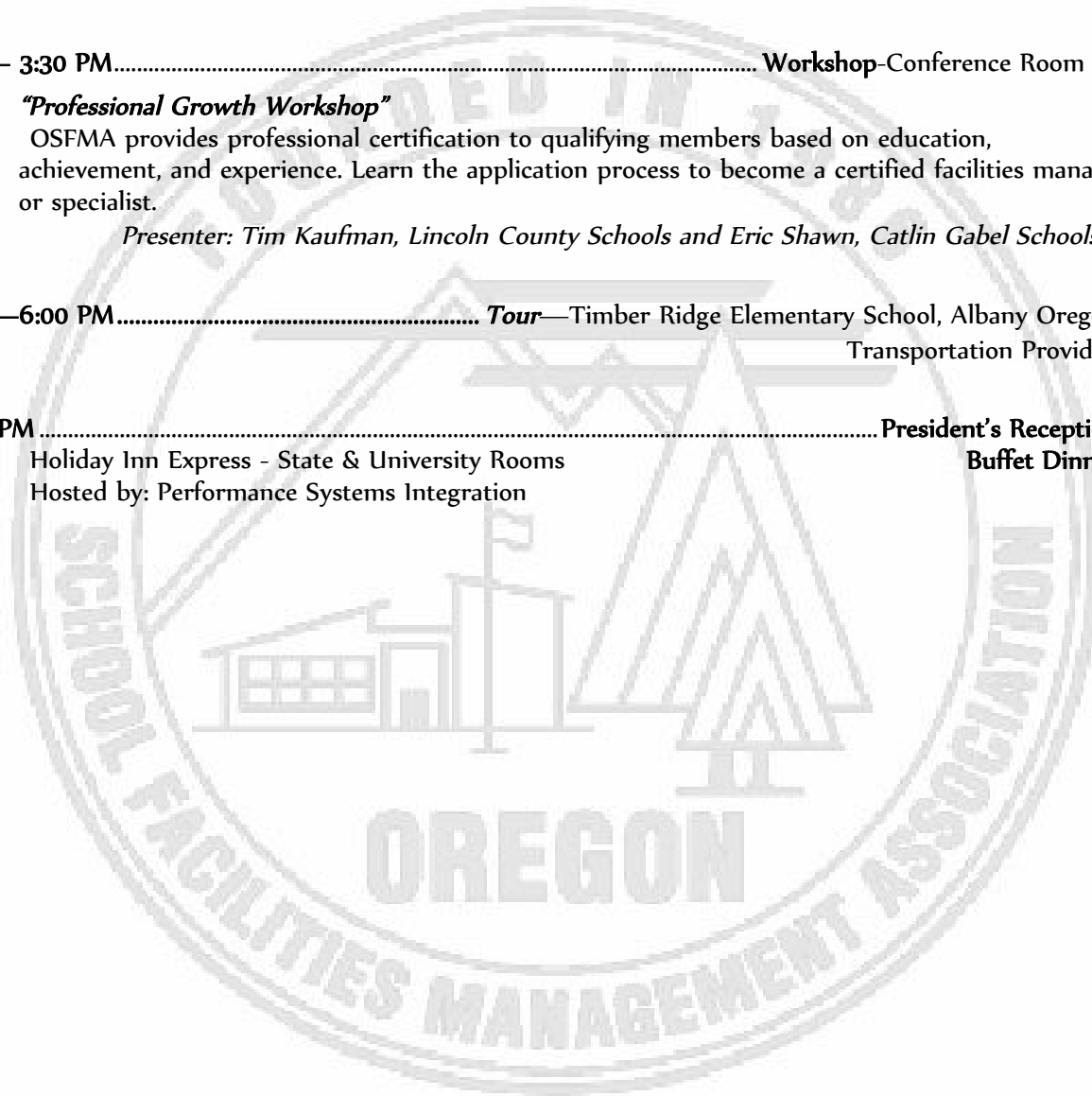

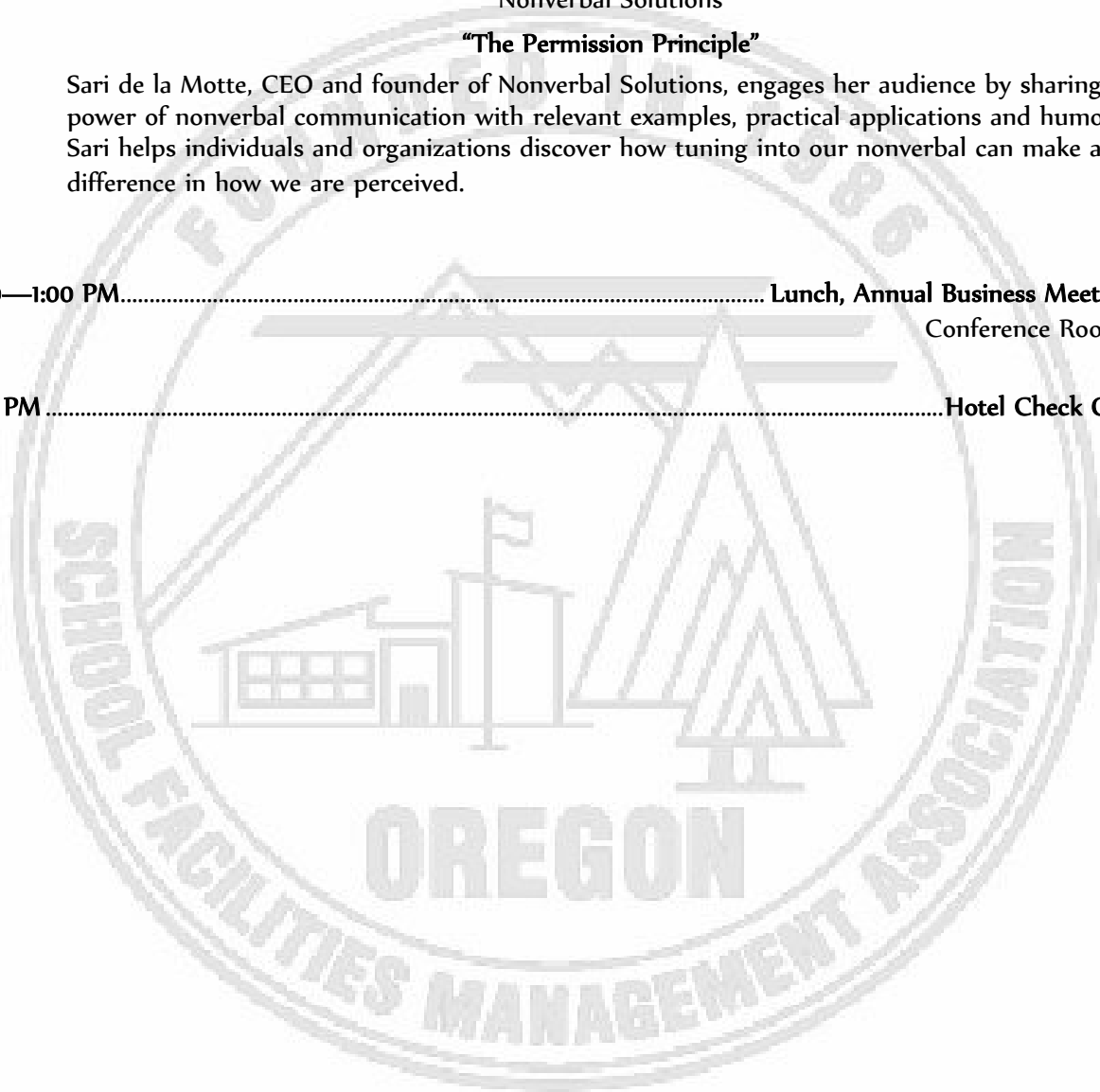
